Continued prohibitions and mandates by the CDC, the State of NY, the governor and RCC college management, have dictated that an event of this magnitude cannot be held because of the ongoing Covid-19 concerns.

However, RAC and NEAF are hard at work making plans and preparations for NEAF 2021, to be held on Saturday, April 10th & Sunday, April 11th at RCC. And for NEAIC, to be held at Crowne Plaza Hotel on Thursday, April 8th and Friday, April 9th. NEAF 2021 is planned to be a most extraordinary event, with over 100 vendors, incredible speakers, workshops and amazing surprises. We guarantee that this will be the most incredible NEAF yet!

We wish that everyone in our extended community remains safe and healthy and we look forward to seeing all of our friends in 2021."
